ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Provide breast-feeding support and education to clients and staff served by the Linn County Department of Health Services, Public Health Program and other health care providers in Linn County. Must possess considerable knowledge of the principles and practices of lactation in order to facilitate professional education to staff, patients, and families. Ability to listen, empathize and respond to patient, family, internal and external partner's needs, and the ability to work independently within the defined guidelines of the job classification.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from a senior high school required. Graduation from an approved school of nursing or a baccalaureate degree from accredited college or University in Health, Nutrition, Nursing or related field of study preferred or certification from International Board Certified Lactation Consultant (IBCLE) examiners. If an RN, must possess a valid license to practice nursing in the State of Oregon. Possession of a valid motor vehicle operator's license and an acceptable driving record at the time of appointment is a requirement of employment.
