The purpose of the Linn County Law Library is to provide access to legal information and resources. Conduct that interferes with this purpose is not permitted. The Law Library is a professional research library; patrons must be engaged in legal research or other activities related to the Law Library's mission. WE CHARGE \$0.20 PER COPY FOR COURT FORMS, GENERAL PRINTING, ETC – (WE DON'T HAVE THE TECHNOLOGY REQUIRED TO ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS – CASH OR CHECKS ONLY)

CONDUCT:

- You will leave the library or areas within the library at closing time or when directed by library staff.
- You will NOT TAKE part in any activity of a suspicious nature or that suggests criminal intention
- Entering the Library barefooted, without a shirt, with offensive body odor or personal hygiene, or being otherwise attired so as to be disruptive to the Library environment. (For safety and hygiene reasons, bare feet or stocking feet are not permitted in the library. Patrons not meeting this requirement will be required to leave the library.)
- You will NOT leave children unattended.

NOISE AND DISTURBANCES:

- You must keep conversations low in volume. (If those nearby can hear the conversation, the volume is too high.) Library staff will ask those violating this policy to reduce the sound level. A second violation will result in being asked to leave the library.
- You should leave the library when taking or making a cell phone call.
- We discourage anyone from using audio or other devices or materials that create excessive noise or in any other way that disrupts patrons or staff.

USE OF THE LAW LIBRARY FACILITY, MATERIALS OR EQUIPMENT:

- No food or beverage consumption is permitted in the law library.
- Marking, damaging, or misusing library materials, equipment, or facilities is NOT permitted.
- You will NOT engage in the theft of library materials, supplies, or equipment.
- You agree to NOT conceal library materials within the library for exclusive use of an individual or group.

The above behaviors may result in one or more of the following responses on the part of Law Library staff, including, but not limited to:

- Refusal of Law Library staff to provide services
- Expulsion from the Law Library for a period of up to 24 hours
- Contacting the County Police Department and/or Public Safety
- Temporary or permanent banning from the Law Library
